- 5) What was the outcome of the Battle at Fort Necessity?
- 6) How did the British troops perform in the war during 1755 & 1756?
- 7) What was the outcome of the Battle of Quebec in 1759?
- 8) What were the terms of the Treaty of Paris in 1763?
- 9) How did the British respond to the attacks of Native Americans in 1763?
- 10) What was the Proclamation of 1763?
- 11) How did the British victory in the French & Indian War affect the British economy?
- 12) What was a “writ of assistance” and why did it anger the colonists?
- 13) What were the three key terms or laws of the Sugar Act?
- 14) What “rights” did the colonists feel that the British government was violating?
- 15) Create a list of British Laws that restricted colonial trade that contributed to the growing resentment of British authority by the American colonists.
