Task 2, Unit 7 – Solutions to Inequalities & Instabilities Graphic Organizer/ Visual

Engaging Scenario: The aftermath of WWII revealed a world that had serious social, economic, political inequalities and instabilities. To address these issues, the United Nations created the Human Rights Council. In order to crystallize the values and tenants of the Council, you have been commissioned to promote a worldwide campaign to initiate dialogue and action to bring about change among UN member states. Your initiatives will consist of researching and identifying key areas of social inequalities, political instability and economic disenfranchisement and providing suggested solutions to the Human Rights Council.

Task 2 Student Directions: In this task students will use information gained in Task 1’s research and organize it in the form of a graphic organizer. Students will then present their proposed solutions to modern day inequalities and instabilities in the world to the Human Rights Council.

- Using the information gathered from Task 1, you will be creating possible solutions to address your issue.
- You will complete the Solutions to Inequalities and Instabilities Graphic Organizer identifying your issue and 5 possible solutions to address the issue. You will identify which solution is the best option for your issue to present to the Human Rights Council.
- You will then create a visual that outlines your various solutions utilizing the Solutions to Inequalities and Instabilities graphic organizer. Students can use any media presentation software for their visual (Power point, Word, etc.). In your presentation you will identify which solution is the best option for your issue to present to the Human Rights Council.
