### KC-5.3.III.D


Increasing questions about political authority and growing nationalism contributed to anticolonial movements.

Increasing discontent with imperial rule led to rebellions, some of which were influenced by religious ideas.



GENERAL SERVICE ENLISTMENT ACT

- (FORMERLY WOULD ONLY SERVE AS FAR AS THEY COULD MARCH IN ONE DAY)
   ALSO ISSUES OF PAY, PROMOTIONS, ETC.

1853 ENFIELD PATTERN RIFLE-MUSKET
 WE'VE SEEN THIS GUN BEFORE:

 1<sup>ST</sup> USED IN THE CRIMEAN WAR (1854-56)
 2<sup>ND</sup> MOST USED GUN IN US CIVIL WAR

 MORE ACCURATE/RANGE DUE TO RIFLING FIRING INSTRUCTIONS:

A greased cartridge

Paper case

Powder

Bullet

Grease

How it was loaded



The soldier tears open the end of the cartridge with his teeth. 2. He pours the powder down the muzzle of his rifle. Then he thrusts the bullet, still wrapped in the cartridge paper which makes it a tight fit, into the muzzle.

He takes his ramrod from its slot beneath the rifle barrel, and rams paper, bullet and powder to the bottom of the barrel.

SEPOY INDIAN TROOPS dividing the spoils after their mutiny against British rule (1857-1859).

- 6k OF THE 40k BRITISH TROOPS WERE KILLED IN THE FIGHTING
- AS MANY AS 80k SEPOYS/INDIAN CIVILIANS DIED IN THE FIGHTING/FAMINE
- TOOK SEVERAL YEARS FOR THE BRITISH TO REGAIN CONTROL IN SOME AREAS

**BRITISH EXECUTIONS OF** PARTICIPANTS IN THE SEPOY REBELLION



- **BEITCO. FORMALLY DISSOVLED**
- INDIA NOW RULED BY THE BRITISH RAJ
  - DIRECT RULE OF INDIA BY UNITED KINGDOM
- FORMAL END TO THE MUGHAL c. 1450-1750
- FINAL EMPEROR ATTACKED BRITISH IN RED FORT
- CAPTURED, SENT TO EXILE IN MYANMAR



1899 ITALY OCCUPIED ERITREA (NEXT TO ETHIOPIA) IN 1899 SIGNED A TREATY OF FRIENDSHIP WITH ABYSSINIA DIFFERENT TRANSLATIONS LED TO CONFLICT








## POLICIES OF THE TAIPING HEAVENLY KINGDOM:

- IMMEDIATELY DECLARED ALL OF THE "TEN THOUSAND NATIONS OF THE WORLD" AS THEIR TRIBUTARY
- <u>CONVERTED</u> DAOIST, CONFUC, & BUDDH TEMPLES TO CHR.
- SOLAR CALENDAR TO REPLACE LUNAR CALENDAR
- FOOT-BINDING IS BANNED; CLASSES WERE BANNED
- SEXES WERE DECLARED EQUAL
  - WOMEN COULD TAKE THE EXAM FOR THE 1<sup>ST</sup> TIME
  - WOMEN COULD BE MILITARY OFFICERS
- SEXES WERE SEPERATED (EVEN MARRIED COUPLES)
- QING HAIRSTYLE ABANDONED; LONG HAIR ACCEPTED
  - BANNED:
    - GAMBLING, OPIUM, TOBACCO, ALCOHOL, POLYGAMY, SLAVERY, & PROSTITUTION (ALL=DEATH PENALTY)
      - FINALLY DEFEATED IN 1864 WITH HELP OF BRITISH & FRENCH FORCES

   OPENED CHINESE MARKETS W/O USING IMPERIALISM





## THE WAR OF THE GOLDEN STOOL IN 1900 WAS THE FINAL CONFLICT IN THE 1823-1900 ANGLO-ASANTE WARS

1900



 BRITISH GOVERNOR OF THE GOLD COAST
 DEMANDED THE ASANTE TURN OVER THE GOLDEN STOOL (THRONE)

• HE THOUGHT THAT:

"if he could only get possession of the ←Golden Stool he would be able to govern the country for all time"

- YAA ASANTEWAA=KING'S SIS
  - KING DIES; HER SON=KING
- HE IS EXILED TO SEYCHELLES
  - GOVERNOR MAKES THE FOLLOWING DEMANDS...

"Your King Prempeh I is in exile and will not return to Ashanti. His power and authority will be taken over by the Representative of the Queen of Britain. Then there is the matter of the Golden Stool of Ashanti. The Queen (Victoria) is entitled to the stool; she must receive it.

## Where is the Golden Stool?

1900

I am the representative of the Paramount Power. Why have you relegated me to this ordinary chair? Why did you not take the opportunity of my coming to Kumasi to bring the Golden Stool for me to sit upon? Howe you may be quite sure that though the Government has not rece the Golden Stool at his hands it will rule over you with the same impartiality and fairness as if you had produced it." Sir Frederick Mitchell Hodgson

- BRITS DID NOT RECOGNIZE THE IMPORTANCE OF THE STOOL
  - IT EMBODIES THE SOUL OF THE ASANTE
    - **DEAD, LIVING, AND YET TO BE BORN**
  - ALSO, NO ONE SAT ON THE STOOL... IT WAS A SYMBOL (THE STOOL EVEN SAT ON A STOOL)



- YAA ASANTEWAA TOOK OVER AS COMMANDER-**IN-CHIEF OF THE ASANTE SHE GATHERED A FORCE OF 20,000+ WARRIORS** TO FEND OFF THE LARGEST EMPIRE IN THE WORLD...
  - SHE SAID TO THESE TROOPS...

"Now I have seen that some of you fear to go forward to fight for our king. If it were in the brave days, chiefs would not sit down to see their king taken away without firing a shot. No white man could have dared to speak to a chief of the Ashanti in the way the Governor spoke to you chiefs this morning. Is it true that the bravery of the Ashanti is no more? I cannot believe it. It cannot be! I must say this, if you, the men of Ashanti, will not go forward, then we will. We, the women, will. I shall call upon my fellow women. We will fight the white men. We will fight till the last of us falls in the battlefields." Supreme Commander Yaa Asantewaa

- **BRITS STARTED TO SEARCH AROUND FOR THE STOOL; YAA FOUGHT BACK**
- SIEGED THE BRITS IN A FORT FOR DAYS
  - **BRITS HAD 6 RIFLES & 4 MAXIM GUNS**
  - SIEGE LASTED UNTIL BRITS SNUCK AWAY
- 1,000 BRITS & 2,000 ASHANTI DIED IN THE WAR
  - **BRITAIN ANNEXED KUMASI (CITY IN GHANA)**
  - **EXILED YAA ASANTEWAA TO SEYCHELLES**
  - ASHANTI REMAINED SEMI-AUTONOMOUS
  - **HODGSON WAS ADMONISHED BY THE PRIME** MINISTER FOR HIS ZEALOUS QUEST FOR THE **GOLDEN STOOL**

- AFTER ALL OF THE BLOODSHED...
- HODGSON NEVER FOUND THE GOLDEN STOOL
