

THERE WERE DOZENS OF PROXY WARS. THE MOST INFAMOUS IN THE AMERICAS WAS THE




- AN AUTOCRATIC DICTATORSHIP HAD RULED NICARAGUA FOR 43 YEARS (1936-1979)
- THEY WERE OUSTED BY THE **SANDINISTAS** (LEFTIST-SOCIALISTS)
 - CARTER (1977-81) HAD TRIED TO WORK WITH THE SANDINISTAS
 - REAGAN HAD A DIFFERENT PLAN: HELP THE CONTRARREVOLUCION (CONTRAS)
- CONTRA WAR (NICARAGUAN CIVIL WAR) KILLED 10,000s OF NICARAGUANS
- 1984 ELECTIONS WERE HELD: SANDINISTAS WON 67% OF THE VOTE
- 1986 PEACE TREATY ENDED THE FIGHTING (COSTA RICAN PRESIDENT WON THE 1987 NOBEL PRIZE FOR BROKERING THE PEACE)

- KOREA DIVIDED AFTER WWII
 - NORTH=USSR CONTROLLED
 - SOUTH=USA CONTROLLED



JUNE 25, 1950: NORTH INVADES SOUTH UN DECIDES TO DISPATCH FORCES

21 NATIONS INVOLVED (88% US; MacARTHUR)



UN COUNTER-OFFENSIVE PUSHES NORTH KOREANS BACK TO THE YALU RIVER

BORDER OF CHINA



- CHINA SENDS 300,000 TROOPS INTO KOREA UN/US FORCES PUSHED BACK TO 38TH PAR.
 - LONGEST RETREAT IN US HISTORY
- FIGHTING BECAME A WAR OF ATTRITION AROUND THE 38TH PARALLEL
 - ARMISTICE SIGNED JULY 27, 1953
 - NO PEACE TREATY EVER SIGNED
- US=36,516 DEAD, SK=137k, NK=400k


Division between East and West Germany after 1949

























JFK IN WEST BERLIN BEFORE HIS FAMOUS ICH BIN EIN BERLINER SPEECH














YELLOW: EAST BERLIN (SODIUM VAPOR LAMPS) BLUE: WEST BERLIN (FLUORESCENT LAMPS)








CUBAN MISSILE CRISIS
