

CHINESE CIVIL WAR

- **CALLED FOR NEW CHINESE CULTURE BASED ON WESTERN STANDARDS**
 - LIKE THE SELF-STRENGTHENING MOVEMENT **ROUND II**
- **GOALS:**
 - VERNACULAR LITER.
 - **END OF PATRIARCHY**
 - **WOMEN'S LIBERATION**
 - **RE-EXAMINATION OF CONFUCIAN CLASSICS**
 - **DEMOCRATIC VALUES**
 - **ORIENTATION TO THE FUTURE (NOT PAST)**



NEW CULTURE MOVEMENT MAY THE 4TH MOVEMENT

- 3000 STUDENTS TAKE TO THE STREETS
- POLITICAL MANIFESTATION OF NEW CULTURE MOVEMENT
- **TURNED VIOLENT**
 - PEOPLE, UNIVERSITIES, STUDENTS JOIN IN ON THE **PROTESTS**
- STUDENTS ARRESTED, THEN RELEASED



CHINESE CIVIL WAR



- 1. SUN SOUGHT FOREIGN SUPPORT TO UNITE CHINA (ONLY USSR OFFERED)
 2. CHINA DEFEATS WARLORDS & UNITES (KMT TRIES TO GET RID OF COMMUN)
- 3. Long March- 1934-5: Comm flee 6,000 mi. In 370 days (mao=comm lead.)
- 4. Coincides with Japanese invasion/occupation of China ('31-'45)
- 5. FIGHTING RESUMES IN 1946; CCP PROMISES TO GIVE LAND TO PEASANTS
- 6. USSR GIVES CCP ALL OF JAPAN'S SURRENDERED WEAPONS
- 7. DUE TO CORRUPTION, US PULLS SUPPORT OF KMT
- 8. ATROCITIES ON BOTH SIDES IN THE MILLIONS
- 9. BY 1950, CCP CONTROLS MAINLAND CHINA (KMT→TAIWAN)

**PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA



* PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA STEP DIE: LAND REFORM

- BEFORE THE END OF THE WAR (1946), CCP LAND REFORM ATTRACTED MILLIONS OF PEASANTS ONE MILLION LANDLORDS WERE EXECUTED... (SOME ESTIMATE AS HIGH AS 28 MILLION)



**PEDPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA STEP TWO: GREAT LEAP FORWARD

- **ECONOMIC & SOCIAL REFORMS FROM 1958-1961**
- GOAL = TRANSFORM CHINA FROM AGRARIAN TO SOCIALIST/INDUSTRIAL SOCIETY
- 1. COLLECTIVIZATION OF THE FARMS 2. INDUSTRIALIZATION
 - FARMERS FORCED INTO STATE RUN FARMS
 - PRIVATE FARMS OUTLAWED

- - RAPID INCREASE IN STEEL PRODUCTION
 - SOME FARMERS FORCED INTO FACTORY

OUTCOME=50+ MILLION DEAD FROM FAMINE



**PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA STEP THREE: ANTI-RIGHTIST MOVEMENT

- AKA THE HUNDRED FLOWERS CAMPAIGN (1956-7)
 - DIFFERENING OPINIONS WERE ENCOURAGED
 - ONCE PEOPLE VOICED THEIR OPINIONS, MAO PURGED THEM



**PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA STEP FOUR: CULTURAL REVOLUTION

- SOCIAL/POLITICAL MOVEMENT TO PRESERVE 'TRUE' COMMUNISM

STUDENT GROUPS OF PARAMILITARY (THINK SA, SS, BLACK SHIRTS) FORMED TO ENFORCE THE CULTURAL REVOL.



REMAINS OF WANLI EMPEROR (MING, 1620) DUG UP & BURNED BY THE RED GUARD



CEMETERY OF CONFUCIUS WAS DESECRATED/STATUES WERE DESTOYED, BODIES DUG UP.






VIETNAM CONFLICT



- VIETNAM BECAME A FRENCH COLONY IN 1859
- VIETNAM BECAME PART OF THE GREATER CO-PROSPERITY SPHERE
- AFTER WWII, FRENCH RETURNED
 - FRANCE FOUGHT VIETNAM
 - **1946-1954**
- AFTER DECISIVE DEFEAT AT DIEN BIEN PHU, FRANCE LEFT VIETNAM
 - DIVIDED AT 17TH PARALLEL
 - 1964: GULF OF TONKIN INCIDENT




- USS MADDOX (ABOVE) WAS FIRED UPON BY N. VIETNAMESE SHIPS
 - ONLY ONE BULLET HOLE FOUND
- LED TO DIRECT US INVOLVEMENT
 - SEND OVER 500k TROOPS
- TWO US PROBLEMS:
 - VIETCONG=GUERILLA WARFARE
 - PROTEST MOVEMENT AT HOME
- VIETNAMIZATION (1969)
 - PROCESS OF TURNING THE FIGHTING OVER TO THE VIETN.
- PARIS PEACE ACCORDS=1975




- SERIES OF 19 PROGRESSIVE REFORMS FROM 1963-1979 BY >
- NON-VIOLENT REGENERATION OF IRANIAN SOCIETY
- **GOAL: MODERNIZE, TRANSFORM IRAN INTO GLOBAL POWER**
- **REFORMS INCLUDED:**
- 1. LAND REFORMS: BOUGHT LAND FROM LANDLORDS & SOLD IT TO THE PEASANTS FOR 30% BELOW MARKET VALUE

 40% OF IRANIANS RECEIVED LAND IN THIS PROGRAM

2. PRIVATIZATION OF GOV'T

OWNED ENTERPRISES:


- SOLD SHARES TO THE PUBLIC
- 3. WOMEN'S SUFFRAGE= (1963)
- 4. LITERACY PROGRAMS
 - 2/3 OF IRAN=ILLIT.
- 5. NATIONALIZATION OF **WATER RESOURCES**
 - BUILT DAMS
 - IRRIGATED LAND FROM 2M ACRES TO 5.6M ACRES
- 6. FREE, COMPULSORY
 - **EDUCATION: AGE 5-14**
- 7. SOCIAL SECURITY



DECREE 900

■ GUATEMALA HAD BEEN RULED BY AUTHORITARIANS SINCE IT WAS FOUNDED BACK IN 1821 (SEE THE FLAG EMBLEM)

- RULERS GEARED ECONOMY TOWARD COFFEE EXPORTS GUATEM Ala
 - TODAY=10TH LARGEST COFFEE PRODUCER (2019)
- AFTER 1898, SERVED AS BANANA REPUBLIC TO THE





U.F.C OWNED 42% OF ARABLE LAND



- DEMOCRATICALLY ELECTED LEADERS IMPLEMENTD DECREE 900
- 1952: UNUSED LAND GREATER THAN 223 ACRES REDISTRIBUTED TO PEASANTS
 - GOAL: MOVE GUAT FROM FEUDAL SOCIETY TO CAPITALIST STATE
 - 1700 ESTATES REDISTRIBUTED TO 500,000 FAMILIES (1/6 OF GUAT. POPUL)
 - PRODUCTION OF CORN, COFFEE AND BANANAS INCREASED (1952-54)
- 1950s: U.F.Co. CONVINCED US GOV'T THAT GUAT=PRO SOVIET
- 1954: US BACKED COUP ENDED 10 YRS OF DEMOCRACY (LED TO 36 YR CIVIL WAR)
 - US NAVY BLOCKADED, CIA BOMBED FROM PLANES (95% OF LAND RETURNED)

LAND REFORM DOESN'T ALWAYS END IN SUCCESS; OR FROM THE RICH TO THE POOR...

MENGISTU HAILE MARIAM TRIED TO MOVE ECON FROM FEUDAL SOVIET STYLE

ALL RURAL LAND NATIONALIZED

- **FARMERS JOINED COLLECTIVE FARMS**
 - COULD NOT SELL ON OPEN MARKET
 - FOOD WAS CONTROLLED/REDISTRIBUTED BY THE DERG (MIL. GOV'T OF ETHIOPIA LED BY→)
- ALL UNDEVELOPED URBAN PROPERTY NATIONAL'D

 - RAISED \$127 MILLION; MENGISTU MARIAM SPENT MOST OF THE MONEY ON GUNS TO FIGHT IN THE CIVIL WAR
