## **GOLDA MEIR**

- IRON LADY OF ISRAELI POLITICS
- BORN:KIEV, RUSSIAN EMPIRE (1898)
  - EMIGRATED TO US IN 1906
- 1<sup>ST</sup> ISRAELI P.M. CALLED HER "THE BEST MAN IN THE GOVERNMENT"
  - EARTH'S 4TH FEMALE P.M.1969-1974
- IN CHARGE DURING MUNICH & YOM KIPPUR WAR

- GOLDA MEIR APPEALED TO THE WORLD TO:
  - "SAVE OUR CITIZENS & CONDEMN THE UNSPEAKABLE CRIMINAL ACTS"
  - LACK OF INTERNATIONAL RESPONSE LED GOLDA MEIR TO TURN TO THE MOSSAD (ISRAELI C.I.A.)
- OPERATION: WRATH OF GOD
  - 20 YEAR HUNT FOR THE BLACK SEPTEMBER TERRORISTS AND SUPPORTERS
    - INCLUDING THE FOUNDER OF BLACK SEPTEMBER (SEEN IN THE CLIP ABOVE)
  - THIS EXCERPT FROM STEVEN SPIELBERG'S MUNICH SHOWS MEIR CONTEMPLATING RETALIATION



### TODAY

- NO PEACE TREATY HAS BEEN SIGNED BETWEEN ISR & PALEST.
- 2017 PEACE PROCEEDINGS ENDED WHEN TRUMP MOVED THE US EMBASSY TO JERUSALEM, RECOGNIZED IT AS THE CAPITAL OF ISRAEL AND CUT MILLIONS IN AID TO THE PALESTINIANS
- ISRAELI WEST BANK WALL (440 MILE WALL)
  - PALESTINIANS CALL IT THE "APARTHEID WALL"
  - STARTED IN 2000 TO RESTRICT PALESTINIAN MOVEMENT
- UN VOTED IN 2003 TO CONDEMN THE WALL (VOTE: 144-4) FOR CONTRADICTING INTERNATIONAL LAW & IT SHOULD BE REMOVED
  - 4 VOTES AGAINST: ISRAEL, USA, MICRONESIA, MARSHALL ISLANDS














## ARUSHA DECLARATION (1967)

- 4. Every citizen has a right to freedom of expression, religion, movement, association...


## REFORMS OF NYERERE:

- Socializing the nation
  - Nationalized banks
  - Communal farming
    - Did not work
    - Led to dependence on foreign food aid
- Expanded Education & Health Care
  - Attempted to unify 100s of ethnic groups by enforcing the use of only one language=Swahili



- NASSER WENT TO THE US TO GET FUNDING FOR THE DAM
- US OFFERED \$56 MILLION BUT WITHDREW IT BECAUSE:
  - NASSER PLAYING BOTH SIDES (NON-ALIGNED)
  - NASSER GOT ARMS DEAL FROM USSR
  - US ALLIES IN REGION DIDN'T GET THIS MUCH \$\$\$
    - TURKEY, IRAQ
  - NASSER WENT TO USSR... KHRUSHCHEV OFFERED \$1.12 B.
