

### NELSON MANDELA

BORN IN 1918 AS ROLIHLAHLA MANDELA (*TROUBLEMAKER*)

"NO ONE IN MY FAMILY HAD ATTENDED SCHOOL... ON THE 1<sup>ST</sup> DAY OF SCHOOL, MY TEACHER GAVE EACH OF US AN ENGLISH NAME... THIS WAS DUE TO THE BRITISH BIAS OF OUR EDUCATION. THAT DAY, SHE TOLD ME MY NEW NAME WAS NELSON. WHY THIS PARTICULAR NAME, I HAVE NO IDEA." –MANDELA, 1994

- ONLY BLACK STUDENT IN LAW SCHOOL
  - EXPERIENCED RACISM 1<sup>ST</sup> HAND
- BECAME POLITICIZED IN LAW SCHOOL
- CO-FOUNDED THE A.N.C. YOUTH LEAGUE
  - YOUTH VERSION OF ANC ANC=AFRICAN NAT'L CONGRESS
  - WANTED INDEPENDENCE
     FROM BRITISH EMPIRE
  - WHITES ONLY ELECTIONS IN 1948 ELECTED OPENLY RACIST GOVERNMENT
    - IMPLEMENTED FULL LEGAL ENFORCEMENT OF APARTHEID




LITERALLY, "APARTNESS" (1948-1990

- **GOV'T MANDATED SEPARATION OF RACES** BASED ON BAASSKAP (BOSS-SHIP)
  - WHITE SUPREMACY
  - **LASTED FROM 1948-1990s**
  - DATES BACK TO DUTCH EMPIRE
    - **LEGALLY CODIFIED IN 1948**

FORCED BLACK AFRICANS TO RELOCATE TO TEN "HOMELANDS" AKA "BANTUSTAN"

**←FORCED** TO CARRY INTERNAL **PASSPORT REGULATED AMOUNT OF** TIME BLACK **AFRICANS** COULD BE **OUT OF THE** HOMELAND





(1952) USING GANDHI'S NELSON NON-VIOLENCE AS A MODEL (ARRESTED) THE DEFIANCE CAMPAIGN FAME GREW WITH EACH PROTEST/ARREST THE FREEDOM CHARTER THE FREEDOM CHARTER (1955) "WE, THE PEOPLE OF SOUTH AFRICA, DECLARE FOR ALL OUR COUNTRY AND THE WORLD TO KNOW: THAT SOUTH AFRICA BELONGS TO ALL WHO LIVE IN IT, BLACK AND WHITE, AND THAT NO GOVERNMENT CAN JUSTLY CLAIM AUTHORITY UNLESS IT IS BASED ON THE WILL OF ALL THE PEOPLE: THAT OUR PEOPLE HAVE BEEN ROBBED OF THEIR BIRTHRIGHT TO LAND. LIBERTY AND PEACE BY A FORM OF GOVERNMENT FOUNDED ON INJUSTICE AND INEQUALITY; THAT ONLY A DEMOCRATIC STATE, BASED ON THE WILL OF ALL THE PEOPLE, CAN SECURE TO ALL THEIR BIRTHRIGHT WITHOUT DISTINCTION OF COLOUR, RACE, SEX OR BELIEF; AND THEREFORE, WE, THE PEOPLE OF SOUTH AFRICA, BLACK AND WHITE TOGETHER - EQUALS, COUNTRYMEN AND BROTHERS - ADOPT THIS FREEDOM CHARTER." MANDELA SPENT THE NEXT FEW YEARS PROTESTING, BEING ARRESTED OVER & OVER DEFYING COURT ORDERS, HE NON-710LENT TRAVELLED THE COUNTRYSIDE INCOGNITO ORGANIZING PROTESTS




- ANTI-APARTHEID ACTIVITIES CONTINUED
- UN RESOLUTION 1761: CONDEMNED
   APARTHEID & CALLED FOR (VOLUNTARILY) BOYCOTT
- BANNED FROM OLYMPICS FROM 1964-1988
- COMPANIES DIVESTED FROM SOUTH AFRICA
- SONGS, MOVIES, CONCERTS WRITTEN TO END APARTHEID (MANDELA'S 70<sup>TH</sup> B-DAY ABOVE)
  - 500 MILLION WATCHED (1988 EARTH=5 BILL)
- WRECKED THE S. AFR ECONOMY (YEARLY INFLAT.=15%)



- THE DRIVE IS THE OPENING SCENE OF THE 2009 FILM INVICTUS... (CLIP ON NEXT SLIDE)




























### AUGUSTO PINOCHET



CONFLICT

1970: SOCIALIST/MARXIST PRESIDENT SALVADOR ALLENDE WAS ELECTED PRESIDENT OF CHILE

 1973: GENERAL→ WITH ARMY, NAVY, AIR FORCE & US SUPPORT LED COUP

- ALLENDE→SUICIDE
  - WITH AN AK-47

PINOCHET RULED AS MILITARY DICTATOR (1973-1990)

- ALL DISSENT WAS SUPPRESSED
- 100K+FLED, 30K TORTURED, 3K EXECUTED
- NECESSARY "TO SAVE THE COUNTRY FROM COMMUNISM"
- OPERATION CONDOR: SOUTH AMERICAN DICTATORS COLLUDED TO FIND DISSIDENTS AND HAVE THEM REMOVED/KILLED






