- BUT, THERE WERE OTHERS...

THE GREATEST KILLER DURING WWI WAS NOT THE WAR ITSELF, RATHER IT WAS

SPANISH FLU

MESS COOK ALBERT GITCHELL REPORTED ILL AT FT RILEY KANSAS ON MARCH 11, 1918 (1ST CONFIRMED CASE OF SPANISH FLU)

- KILLED HEALTHY YOUNG ADULTS MOST
- CREATED A CYTOKINE STORM (IMMUNE SYS)
- KILLED IN 24 WKS WHAT AIDS KILLED IN 24 YRS
- KILLED 7% OF INDIA, 17% OF JAPAN, 5% OF INDONESIA, ETC.
- HURTS THE CENTRAL POWERS MORE THAN THE ALLIED POWERS

5. 3RD PANDEMIC (CHINA).....12M

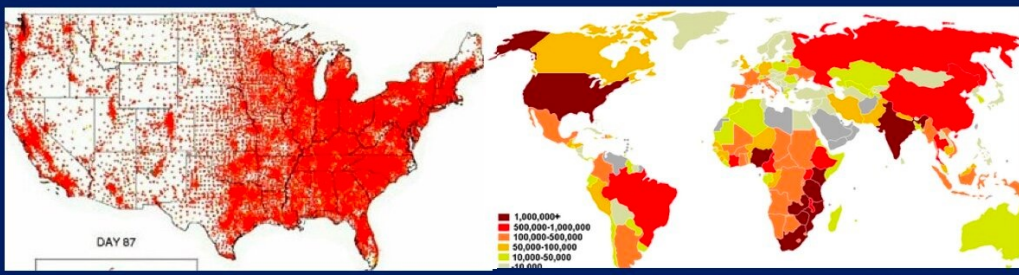

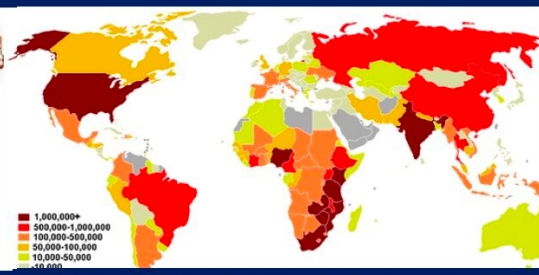

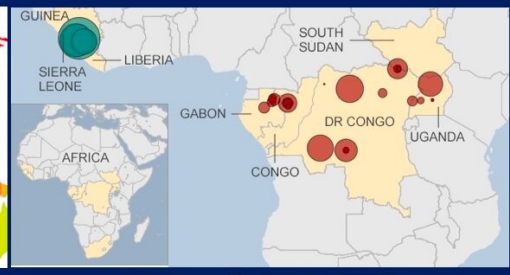

1918 FLU OUTBREAK (USA)



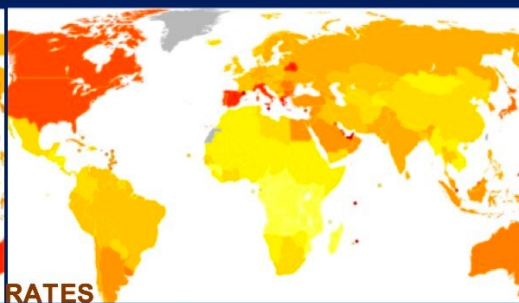

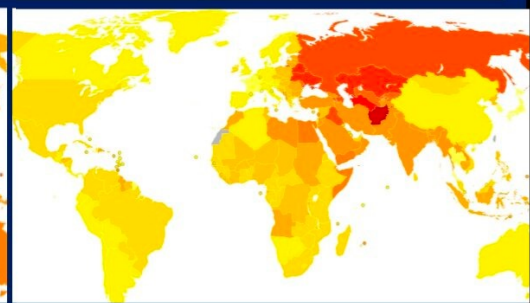

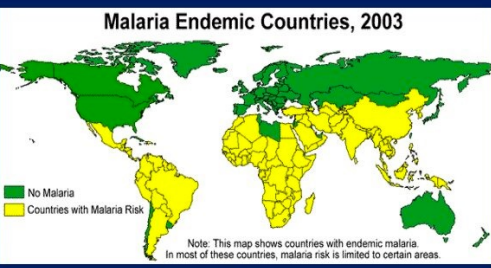

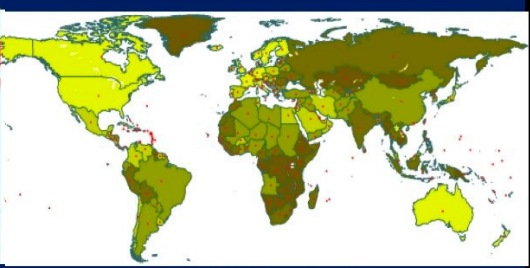
